

The 2014 - 2015 Pupil Premium funding for Great Denham Primary School is **£84,500**.

The Pupil Premium funding that is received by the school annually is used in a variety of ways in order to improve pupil attainment and to help overcome any barriers to learning. We have researched and analysed extensively, to inform us of the best ways to use this money. Below we have outlined how we have used and are planning to use the money effectively~

Early Years intervention:

- EYFS and other groups have been screened to identify vulnerable groups and are supported in class, through targeted intervention.

1-2-1 tutoring:

- Lessons have been timetabled to allow individual tutoring for targeted children by trained teaching assistants in reading, writing or maths

Family Support Worker

- A family support worker has been employed to work with many of our children. She will support families in many aspects of school and home life.

Teaching Assistant Support

- Since April 2013 the school has employed teaching assistants to work in each class and who will focus in on supporting children. These children have individual targets to ensure that focused support is appropriate and that it ensures that any gaps in achievement are narrowed quickly.

Pupil Progress Meetings

- Release time is planned for teachers to allow for 'pupil progress meetings' to ensure that the gap is narrowed for vulnerable groups.

One to one i pad scheme

- Subsidised access to the 1-1 i pad scheme for children in Year 5

Increasing access to sports and the arts and residential trips

- Subsidised access to a range of extra curricular clubs as well as support for accommodation on residential trips (Year 5/6)
