Educational Psychologist


Our school Educational Psychologist, Aneta Warrentowicz, will be offering 20 minute drop in appointments for both teachers and parents on the 24th March from 9.30am to 12.30pm. All appointments will be virtual and conducted online.

These sessions are an opportunity to discuss issues or concerns you may have which are impacting your child in school or at home and plan some strategies that may help them to move forward.

Reminder to parent who have 1 to 1 iPads

Please can you ensure that you have backed up and reset your child's iPad as per the instructions sent out recently. Over the next few weeks our technicians will be gathering all the iPads to check they are correctly enrolled on the new MDM and enrolling any that are not. If your child's device has not been backed up they will lose any data on it when this happens. As per our Acceptable Use Policy, if the iPads are not enrolled on the MDM they cannot be used in school. Over the coming term we will be reviewing the apps that pupils have available to them and the access they have to download their own content but we need to get the system set up in the first instance. Year 6 iPads will be released from the MDM prior to leaving Great Denham.
