Surge Testing in Bedford Borough

With Government figures showing that Bedford Borough has the third highest COVID-19 rate in the country, surge testing is being rolled out to selected areas of Bedford Borough.

Working in partnership with NHS Test and Trace, everyone (adults and children) living, working, or studying in the **Kingsbrook**, **Cauldwell** and **Queens Park** areas of Bedford Borough and the village of **Wixams**, are strongly encouraged to take a PCR COVID-19 test this week, even if they are not showing symptoms. This will help to identify cases and ensure that people self-isolate, with the appropriate support.

These areas of Bedford Borough were chosen based on close analysis of the spread of COVID-19 in recent days. Testing and self-isolating where required will, help us to control the spread of the virus.
