Last week we had a very special visitor come in to see us, Mrs Armitage. She got lost on the playground but luckily we were there and were able to guide her back home. Since then the children have
















designed and built their own component to go on her magnificent bike. We have had music boxes, wings, umbrellas, anchors and many more fabulous ideas.
